A short history of my Ministry



I was ordained as a priest on 15th January 2015. I worked as an assistant parish priest for one year in my native state Kerala. There after I was send to a mission place in Andhra Pradesh. Andhra Pradesh is a mission state where we have plenty of Christian families from backward communities, where 80% of them live below poverty line. Most Andhra Christians are Protestants, but there is also a significant number of Roman Catholics.

We began our mission among Roman Catholics by adopting a mission center from Visakhapatnam Arch diocese in 2008. We worked for the upliftment of marginalized people by doing different ministries likewise, School ministries, parish ministries, counseling and retreat preaching. Through our various ministries we could make an impact in the life of people.

One of the greatest challenge that we are facing is discrimination based on cast. We work among the scheduled cast and scheduled tribe people. They are separated by cast and they may not cross the line dividing from the higher castes. They face inequality in all the aspects. When we began our mission we noticed many Scheduled cast students are deprived of education along with high cast students.



Scheduled cast and tribes are not able to afford huge fee structure to teach their children in a reputed schools mainly owned by High Cast people. So we realized the need of having a school to support those students who are deprived of education based on their cast and financial situation. So we provide quality education to those students with a small fee scale. We give free education to many students realizing their family situation.

We initiated our school ministry in 2012 to improve individual social position and standard of living. I was appointed as a school director in 2016. Since 2016, I am working among these students to improve their overall well-being. I along with the help of my confreres and benefactors, work for empowering individuals by providing them with knowledge and skills.



We also focus on Poverty alleviation, health and well-being, community development, social equality, and economic growth.

I trust in the providence of All Mighty God and continued intercession of Our Heavenly mother. I firmly believe that our heavenly Mother brought La Salette Missionaries to this rural area to make changes in the life of people.

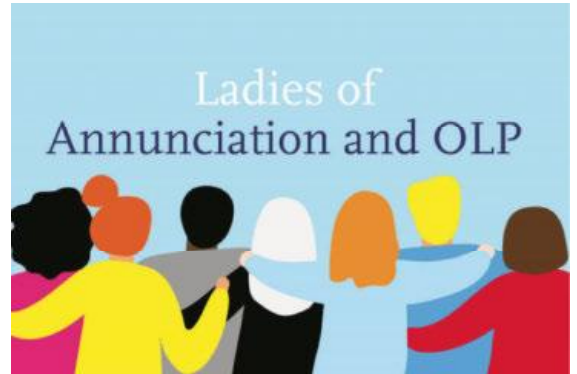

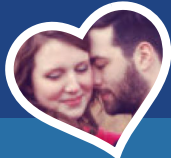
