Guided by our relationship with Jesus Christ and inspired by the Holy Spirit, we fulfill our baptismal calling through:

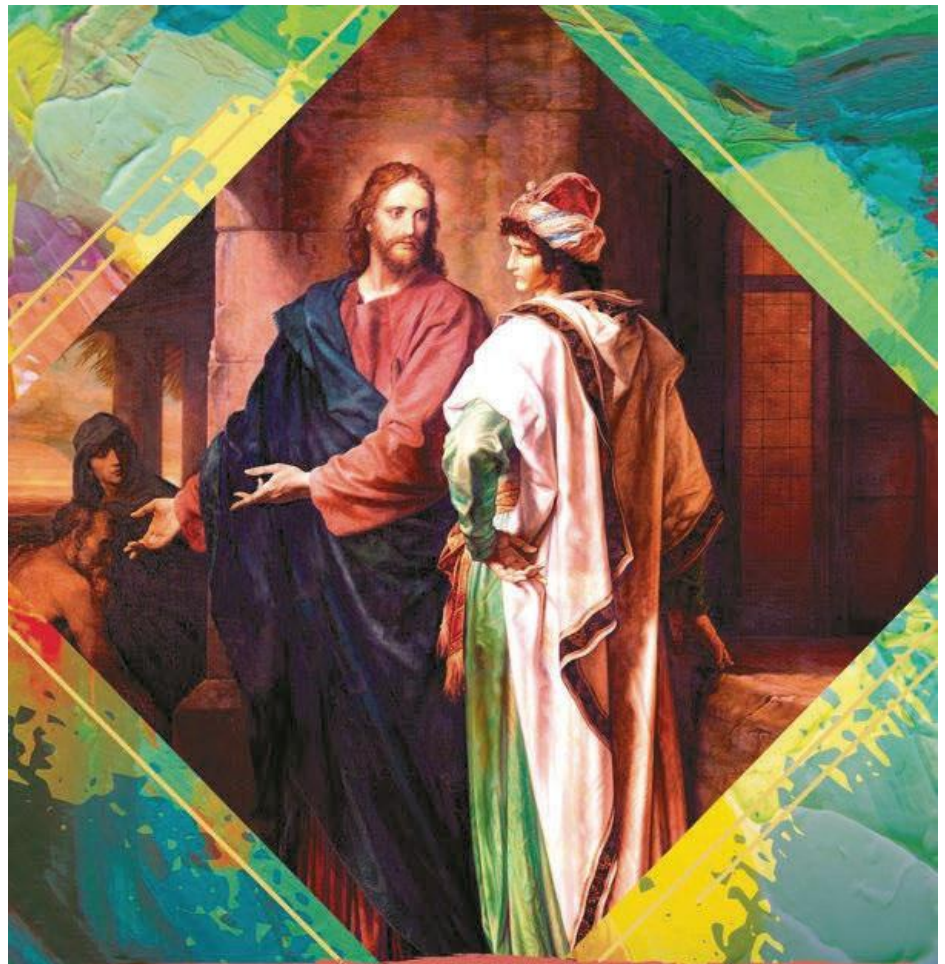

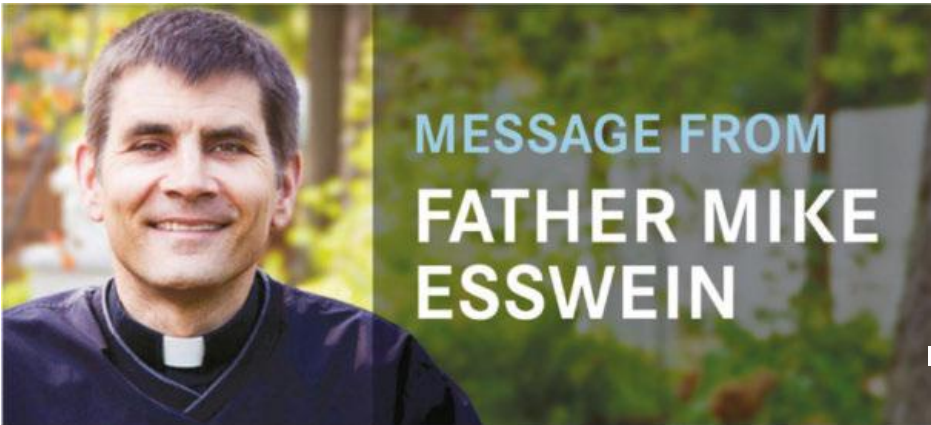
Eucharistic Adoration

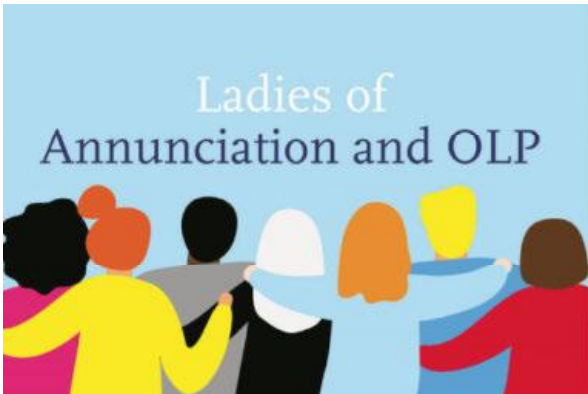
Take some time at the start of the Advent season to get together! We will begin with
