



Dear Friends,

On Christmas Eve, Pope Francis commenced the Jubilee Year with the opening of the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica. The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home. In the Bible, a Jubilee year was to be marked every 50 years, since this would be an "extra" year, one which would happen every 49 years (cf. Leviticus 25:8-13). It was intended to be marked as a time to reestablish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation, and involved the forgiveness of debts, the return of misappropriated land, and a fallow period for the fields. The Church celebrated its first Jubilee, also known as a "Holy Year," in the year 1300. The frequency of Holy Years changed over time, initially celebrated every 100 years, then briefly every 50 years, and then established to be celebrated every 25 years. Participation in a Holy Year includes making a pilgrimage to a designated Holy Site where the faithful offer prescribed prayers and holy practices, availing themselves to receive an indulgence offered by the Holy Father. Originally, the Roman Basilicas of Saint Peter and Saint Paul were established as the Holy Sites for pilgrimage. Years later, to allow more of the faithful to participate and receive the graces being made available to them during a Jubilee year, local churches were designated for the faithful throughout the world. The Holy Sites for Jubilee 2025 within the Archdiocese of Saint Louis, designated by Archbishop Rozanski, include the following:

Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis (New Cathedral)
Basilica of Saint Louis, King of France (Old Cathedral)
Holy Spirit Adoration Sisters at Mount Grace Convent &
Chapel (Convent of the 'Pink Sisters')

Carmel of Saint Joseph at the Chapel of the Most Precious Blood (Carmelites on Clayton Rd)

Passionist Nuns of St. Louis (Ellisville - immediate neighbor of St. Clare of Assisi Parish)

Saint Mary's of the Barrens - National Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal (Perryville)



THE JUBILEE PRAYER



St. Patrick's Salad & Casserole

We would like to thank all of you for bringing salads, "ranch" dressing and casseroles every month. We are waging the war against hunger with our weap-

ons of 1 lb. packages of salad, fresh vegetable, ranch dressing and casseroles. Extra gifts of packages of cookies or a loaf of bread are also appreciated. The coolers will be on the porch at 128 E Glendale Road by 7am and will remain there until 9pm.

Only casseroles, bags of salad, and vegetables go in the coolers. Please place all non-perishables in the large Rubbermaid tub. This is critical since there are days when I will not be available to sort and rearrange placement of food. We need every bit of cooler space for the casseroles and salad.

If you prepare a casserole for the program please make sure you label the lid <u>before</u> you place it in the freezer, the writing stays on much better that way. It needs to say "ALUMNI CLUB" and THE TYPE OF CASSEROLE on the lid. This makes it possible for St. Patrick's to know what is in the pan, as they serve a different type of casserole each evening.

Feed the Homeless needs a casserole maker!

Our Annunciation Feed the Homeless Program needs a monthly casserole maker. Each casserole feeds 12 people and they are counting on us to provide that hot meal on our assigned day. The task of a casserole maker involves purchasing the ingredients, preparing, and freezing the casserole in advance of the drop off day. 


