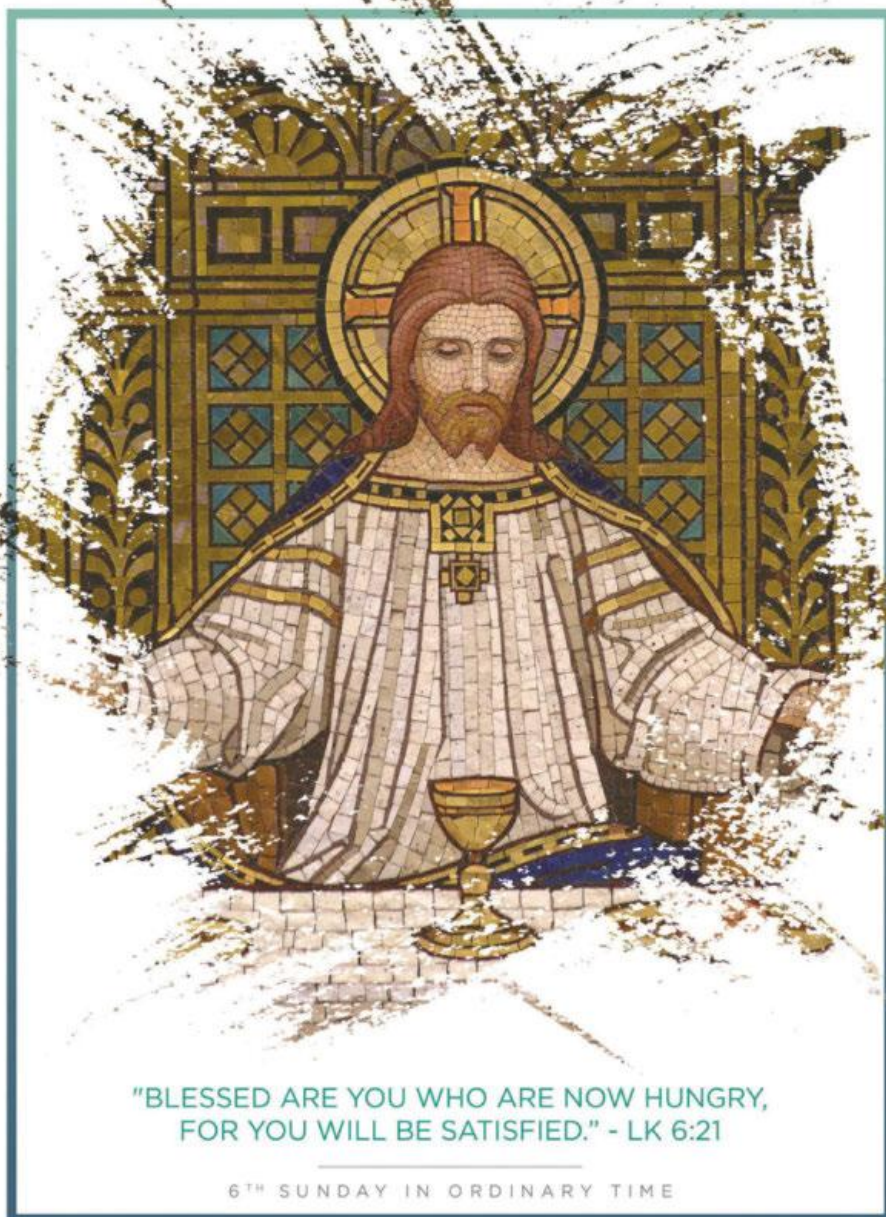

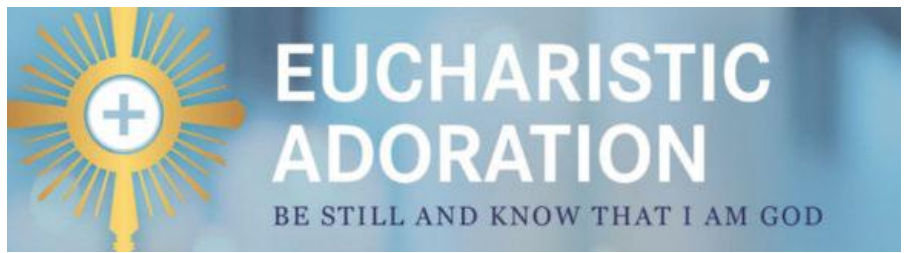

In keeping with our 2025 theme, the Option for the Poor and Vulnerable, the Justice Seekers invite members of Annunciation and OLP parishes to participate in an eight-week Just Faith program on Faith and Immigration Justice. 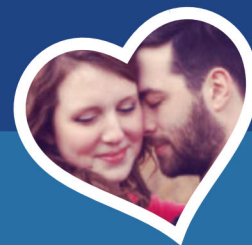

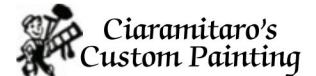
