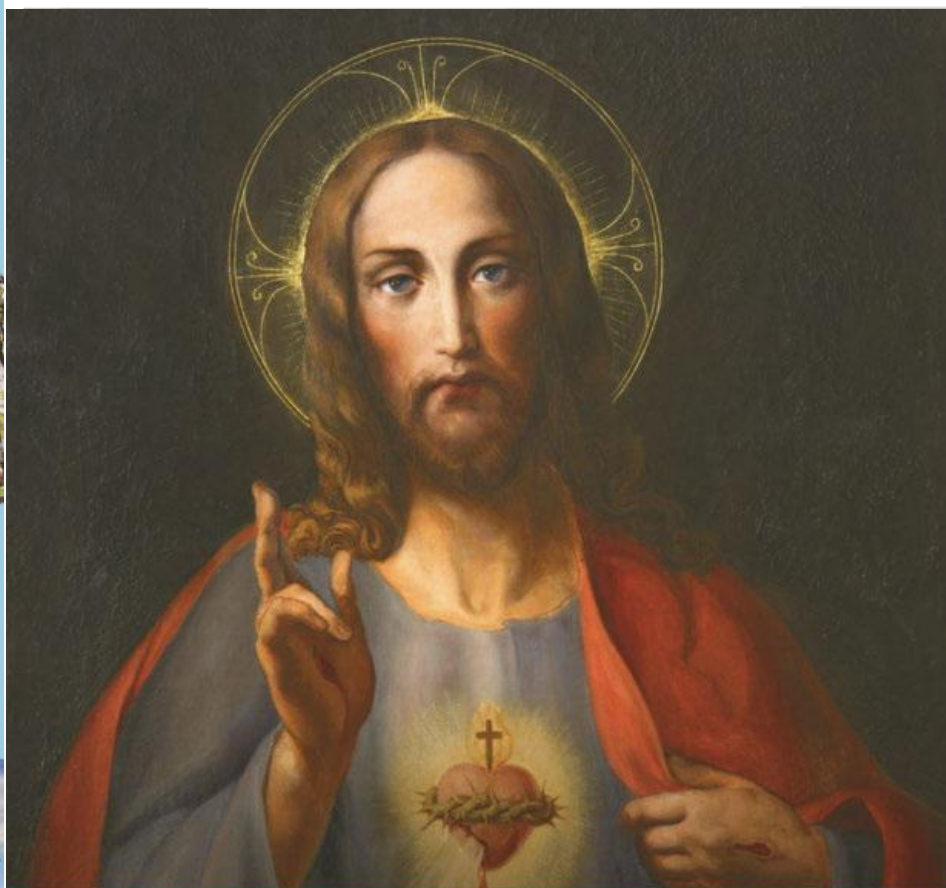

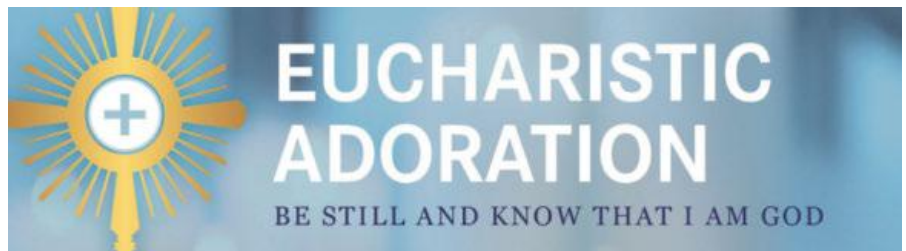

ATTENTION! URGENT NEED FOR BLOOD DONATIONS

We recently hosted a blood drive at OLP and collected a record number of donations. But sadly, the recent snow and ice events have caused many blood drives to be cancelled. Impact Life is down about 513 blood donations from Feb. 12- cancellations alone! They are asking all eligible donors (your last blood donation must have been at least 8 weeks ago) who can safely travel to a nearby mobile blood drive or Donor Center location to help make up for these lost donations. To find a donor center or mobile blood drive, call (800) 747-5401, or book online at www.bloodcenter.org. If you tell them at registration that you are donating for Our Lady of Providence, sponsor code #9177, they will credit us with your donation.

Also, all donors will receive a voucher to redeem for their choice of a gift as listed below. For more information, see www.bloodcenter.org/now.

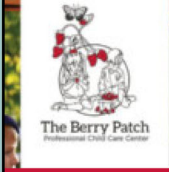

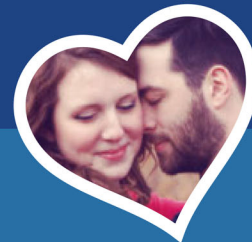

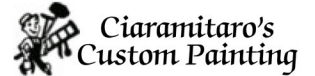
