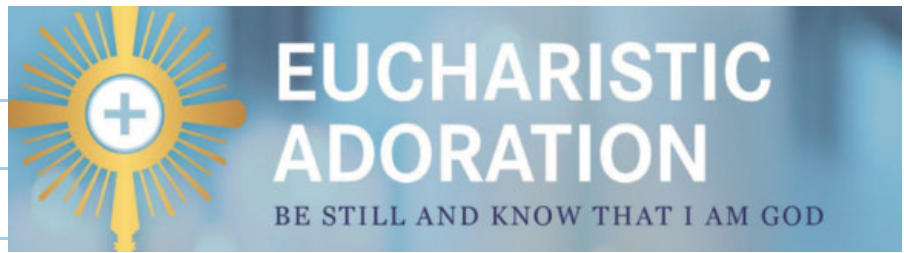

The Season of Lent is passing quickly.

Each week we offer the opportunity for prayer with our parish communities. On Tuesday evenings at 6pm, we either pray Evening Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours at Annunciation, or we pray the Stations of the Cross with the additional option for celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation at Our Lady of Providence. We skip back-and-forth, week to week, between our two parishes and these two options of prayer. This Tuesday, March 25th, on the solemnity and parish feast day of Annunciation, we will be at Annunciation for Evening Prayer. In addition to Evening Prayer, you are invited, but not expected, to stay afterwards and join other Catholics from throughout the Archdiocese who will be here for “Who Am I?” This evening gathering is sponsored by the North Vicariate Office whose job includes offering education and faith formation opportunities for the local Catholic parishes of this area of the Archdiocese. It’s part of a four-part series, with each session being held at one of four different parish locations in the Northern Vicariate. We are pleased to have been asked to sponsor one of these sessions at Annunciation. The topic for March 25th is on how we can concretely be disciples for Christ whose job is to make disciples for the Lord. It will be a laid-back evening that includes food, drink, and ideas on living this mission in the here and now of today.

Don’t forget... this Friday we will have another fish fry at Providence! If you don’t have plans for dinner, please join us in the cafeteria for a fun evening and good food. Everyone from Providence and Annunciation are invited and most welcomed! I hope to see you there!

2025 Lenten Offering

The 2025 Lenten Offering will support Holy Redeemer Haiti Committee's ongoing Tree Currency program to promote reforestation, soil renewal, and better farming practices in the St. Jean area.

Here are the results of the program after 18 months:

- 1) 41,937 trees were transplanted in farmers' plots, on degraded hillsides and in forest gardens (Goal: 22,500)
- 2) 49 forest gardens were established on non-agricultural land enabling the co-cultivation of valuable trees and crops
- 3) Agronomic training and farming tools were provided to >400 farmers
- 4) High-quality black bean- and maize seeds were shared with >400 farmers
- 5) A community seed bank was established as a future community resource for high-quality seeds

In order to fully fund this 5-year program into 2028, we need to raise an additional \$33,000. A donation of \$75 will sponsor a farmer for 1 year and enable the planting of ~40 trees. A donation of \$200 will sponsor a farmer for 2 1/2 years and enable the planting of ~100 trees. Of course, any donation amount is welcome!

In the back of Annunciation church, we have a poster that provides more details about the Tree Currency program. The QR code will enable online donations. In addition, we have provided envelopes for those who would prefer to mail a check to the Holy Redeemer office. Write "Haiti Lenten offering" in memo. We thank you for your past support of our Haiti mission work and ask that you consider giving to this Lent.

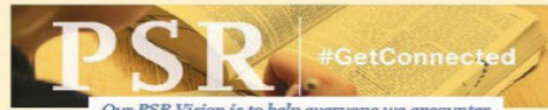

Lenten Activities with PSR Families



In helping our PSR students and families enter more deeply into this Lenten season, we began Lent with providing various resources to families, such as the little black books, prayerful reflections, CRS Rice bowls, and

encouraging families to attend their parish Ash Wednesday Mass. Ash Wednesday was a PSR night at the Annunciation PSR location where PSR children practiced participating in some of the liturgical ministries, such as lectors, choir, gift bearers, and servers. The children did a great job, and we were grateful to celebrate the Mass together as a PSR community.

Family nights with Masses, activities, speakers, and prayer are central to the PSR experience. 1st-8th grade family nights include the Meet the Teacher Popsicle Party night, Family Rosary night, Feed the Hungry night (making sandwiches for those in need), Vocations night, and many other calendar events. We also offer family formation nights for each grade level. Amy Buehrle, our Adult Faith Formation Coordinator in PSR, leads the parents and children of each grade-level to gather as a small group to pray together as a family, learn more about their faith, and have family discussions centered around faith.



This month, the 3rd grade family night focused on praying Stations of the Cross during Lent. A PSR night of beautiful weather allowed the families to go outside to walk and pray the Stations of the Cross together. The families

returned to church where they listened to music and entered into prayer and discussion about the Stations and reflections. They were invited to move around and look at the Stations of the Cross inside the church, then sit by the Station that stood out to them in their reflection. The evening concluded with imaginative prayer and sharing their reflections as a group. We are grateful to help our children and families continue to grow in their relationship with Jesus.

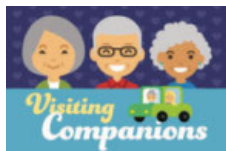

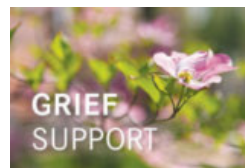

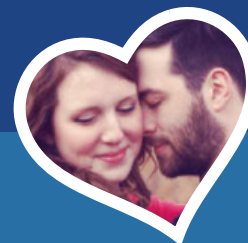
