Lenten Prayer Opportunity- Kairos Prison Ministry

Lenten Prayer Opportunity - Kairos Prison Ministry

Many of us have found ways to feed the hungry, welcome the stranger, clothe the naked, or care for the sick. What about visiting the imprisoned? This year you have the opportunity to do so vicariously. Kairos Prison Ministry will be holding a 4-day retreat at the Menard Correctional Center in Chester, IL from April 1-4. During this retreat, through talks, discussions and Chapel meditations, prisoners learn that they are worthy of God's love, light and grace. That no matter who they are or what they have done, God will forgive them. You can be an instrumental part of this retreat! How?

- 1.) Be a prayer warrior! Knowing that many people are praying for them during this retreat has a profound impact on the participants. It softens hearts hardened by years of incarceration and feelings of abandonment, opening the door for the Holy Spirit to enter. If you are interested, email Lou Rotter at LouRotter@gmail.com. You are asked to provide a first name and last initial and to pray for the inmates during this retreat. Knowing others are praying for them helps build them up.
- 2.) Financial contributions. These retreats have a cost associated with them. 2025 Lenten Offering

The 2025 Lenten Offering will support Holy Reedeemer Haiti Committee's ongoing Tree Currency program to promote reforestation, soil renewal, and better farming practices in the St. Jean area. Here are the results of the program after 18 months: **Donate here**

- 1) 41,937 trees were transplanted in farmers' plots, on degraded hillsides and in forest gardens (Goal: 22,500)
- 2) 49 forest gardens were established on non-agricultural land enabling the co-cultivation of valuable trees and crops
- 3) Agronomic training and farming tools were provided to >400 farmers
- 4) High-quality black bean- and maize seeds were shared with >400 farmers
- 5) A community seed bank was established as a future community resource for high-quality seeds

In order to fully fund this 5-year program into 2028, we need to raise an additional \$33,000. A donation of \$75 will sponsor a farmer for 1 year and enable the planting of ~40 trees. A donation of \$200 will sponsor a farmer for 2 1/2 years and enable the planting of ~100 trees. Of course, any donation amount is welcome!

In the back of Annunciation church, we have a poster that provides more details about the Tree Currency program. The QR code will enable online donations. In addition, we have provided envelopes for those who would prefer to mail a check to the Holy Redeemer office. Write "Haiti Lenten offering" in memo. We thank you for your past support of our Haiti mission work and ask that you consider giving to this Lent.


